**Helpers** do not have to teach. They assist with:

- moving kids to and from the classroom quietly
- helping kids find their name tags
- · passing out craft supplies
- helping the youngest kids do the craft
- taking kids to the bathroom

Due to the large number of kids (often more than 30 on the busiest days) we need to have at least two Helpers in addition to the Teacher each Sunday.

Anyone who wants to serve as a **Teacher** instead of a Helper is welcome to do so! We'd make sure one of our experienced teachers was there as a Helper that day to support you. There is a lesson book that we use based on the Sunday readings and the crafts are selected for you ahead of time. Contact Sofia if you are interested in giving it a try!

## **General information**

Children's Liturgy meets during the 10:00 mass most Sundays during the school year. Sometimes it is cancelled for breaks/holidays, if the Teacher is unable to make it, or if there are not enough Helpers. Having your email address helps us be able to notify you in advance whenever possible.

The children are dismissed before the first reading and go to the downstairs classroom with their Teacher and Helpers. We do a short lesson, usually about the day's Gospel reading, followed by a craft. We return to mass around the time of the distribution of the Eucharist.
