(Sometimes songs are not appropriate for a wedding liturgy and would be better for the wedding reception.) Most of the songs listed here are found in the Breaking Bread hymnal. Selections for the liturgy will include Processional, Preparation of Gifts (Offertory), Communion, Recessional. Some couples will include a meditation to the Blessed Virgin Mary. You will need to choose whether you want to have songs sung by everyone present or by the soloist. Please discuss preferred options for the Processional with the celebrant before finalizing your music choices.
